\*\* The money must be kept in bank account at least 1 year before withdrawing and, within another next year, the money must be left in the account with the amount of not less than THB 1,500,000 and can only be spent in Thailand.

(8) Certificate of criminal record clearance from the country of nationality. In case the applicants have permanent residence in other country, they must provide the aforementioned document from both country of nationality and country of permanent residence.

(9) Medical certificate from the country where the applicants apply visa stating that applicants do not have any prohibited diseases according to the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 (B.E.2535) which include Leprosy, Tuberculosis, Elephantiasis, drug addiction, third stage of Syphilis. The medical certificate must not be issued over 3 months.

### 6.3 For a visit of up to 14 days **\*\* Currently suspended \*\***

Passport holders from the following countries/territory are not required to obtain a visa when entering Thailand for tourism purposes and will be permitted to stay in the Kingdom for a period of not exceeding 14 days on each visit ('Bilateral Agreement Arrangements'): Cambodia, Myanmar.

#### **Please note:**

- \* Visa on Arrival is temporarily suspended between 1 January-31 March 2021.
- \* For Nigerian nationalities and passport holders, Certificate of Clearance from NDLEA and authenticated by the Ministry of Foreign Affair of Nigeria and the Royal Thai Embassy in Abuja, Nigeria is required.

- \* The document to be submitted for non-immigrant visa application is contingent upon necessities and appropriateness of purposes stated in the application form.
- \* Consular officers reserve the rights to request additional documents as deemed necessary.
- \* In the absence of a required document, a letter explaining the unavailability of such document must be provided.
- \* The applicant must sign on each page of the copy.

- \* Documents in foreign languages must be translated into Thai. If translated into English, it should be notarized by notary organs or the applicant's diplomatic/ consular mission.
- \* Those who wish to stay longer or may wish to change their type of visa must file an application for an extension at the Office of Immigration Bureau located on Government Center B, Chaengwattana Soi 7, Laksi, Bangkok 10210, Tel 0-2141-9889 or at local Immigration Bureau. The extension of stay as well as the change of certain type of visa is solely at the discretion of the Immigration Officer.
