Information for entering Thailand during the COVID-19 situation

1. Persons allowed to enter Thailand

Pursuant to the Regulation issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 12) dated 30 June B.E. 2563 (2020), as amended by the Regulation issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 13) dated 31 July B.E. 2563 (2020), "Travel from other countries into the Kingdom using any transportation routes, whether by land, water or air, or by using vehicles, whether motor vehicles, vessels, aircrafts or any other types of vehicles in order to enter into the Kingdom, may be allowed in accordance with conditions, timeframes and criteria determined by the Prime Minister or persons having powers under the laws on immigration, laws on air navigation and laws on communicable diseases in order to prevent the spread of the disease and to set up orderly arrangements of the number of travellers entering into the Kingdom according to the capabilities of officers in screening and organising places for the isolation, quarantine or control for observation of passengers or travellers entering into the Kingdom, as follows:

- (1) Thai nationals;
- (2) Exempted persons or persons who are specified, permitted or invited by the Prime Minister or Chief Official responsible for remedying the emergency situation to enter into the Kingdom pertaining to necessity, whereby conditions and timeframes may also be prescribed;
- (3) Persons on diplomatic or consular missions or under international organisations, or representatives of foreign governments or agencies performing their duties in Thailand, or any other persons in international agencies, which the Ministry of Foreign Affairs gives permission pertaining to necessity, including their spouses, parents or children;
- (4) Carrier of goods pertaining to necessity, who shall promptly depart after completing their mission;
- (5) Vehicle operators and crew members of vehicles, who need to enter into the Kingdom pursuant to their mission, with a clear scheduled time of departure;
 - (6) Non-Thai nationals who are spouses, parents or children of Thai nationals;
- (7) Non-Thai nationals who have a certificate of residence, including their spouses and children;
- (8) Non-Thai nationals who have a work permit or have been granted permission to work in the Kingdom in accordance with Thai laws, including their spouses or children or foreign workers who have been granted to work through their employers or licencees who are permitted to bring in foreign workers to work in the Kingdom
- ** These include: (i) Work permit holders in religious / missionary works; (ii) Work permit holders who are volunteers or NGO workers.
- (9) Non-Thai nationals who are students of educational establishments in Thailand approved by Thai authorities, including their parents or guardians, except for students of non-formal schools in accordance with laws on private schools or of any other similar private educational establishments;
- (10) Non-Thai nationals who need to receive medical treatment in Thailand, including their accompanying persons, except for treatment for COVID-19 **currently suspended**; and

(11) Non-Thai nationals who have been granted permission to enter into the Kingdom under special arrangements between Thai government agencies and other countries, or persons or groups of persons who have been granted permission by the Prime Minister upon the submission for consideration after the examination and review by the Ad Hoc Committee for the Consideration of the Relaxation of the Enforcement of Measures to Prevent and Suppress the Spread of the Communicable Disease Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19), and shall comply with disease prevention measures determined by the Ad Hoc Committee.

These include:

- 11.1 Thailand Elite visa holders
- 11.2 Long Stay (O-A), Long Stay 10 years (O-X) and Non-Immigrant O (Retirement) visa holders
 - 11.3 APEC Business Travel Card holders
- 11.4 Special Tourist Visa (STV) holders, Tourist Visa (TR) holders, and those who are eligible for visa exemption (https://www.thaiembnepal.org.np/downloads/ Countries-and-territories-visa-exemption.jpg)
- 11.5 Non-Immigrant Visa (Non-B) holders, who conduct business, meeting or investing/saving in Thailand
 - 11.6 Approved film crew members
 - 11.7 Transit passengers
 - 11.8 Those who participate in sport activities/tournaments
- 11.9 Those who on a short-term basis study, train or do an internship or attend religious activities in Thailand
- 11.10 Former Thai citizens, and those who are requested for court appearance in Thailand

2. Application procedures for Certificate of Entry (COE)

Non-Thai Nationals who fall under one of the following categories, namely (2), (3) and (6) - (11), and wish to enter Thailand are required to apply for Certificate of Entry (COE) at https://coethailand.mfa.go.th/, and visa (should they currently not have an appropriate visa) at the Royal Thai Embassy.

Applications for the Certificate of Entry (COE) will be considered on a case-bycase basis, taking into account the urgency, need, and reasons provided in the application form. ** Please plan at least 7 days for the COE and visa application processes.**

3. Flights to Thailand

The Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Conditions for Aircraft Permission to Enter Thailand (No.2) dated 2 July B.E. 2563 (2020) bans aircrafts, including commercial aircrafts, from entering into the airport in Thailand, except for certain circumstances.

In this regard, travellers may enter Thailand by repatriation or cargo flights organised by the Royal Thai Embassy or by semi-commercial flights. For further details about semi-commercial flights such as operating airlines, routes, airfares, and reservation procedures, travellers must contact the airlines directly.

4. Visa application

In addition to the Certificate of Entry (COE), applicants who currently do not hold appropriate visa to enter Thailand are required to apply for an appropriate visa at the Royal Thai Embassy. 6. Online application system for the Certificate of Entry (COE)

As of 1 November 2020, the applicants can apply for the Certificate of Entry (COE) through an online application system at https://coethailand.mfa.go.th/. Please allow at least 7 days for the Embassy to process your application with the following steps:

<u>Step 1</u> Register and fill in your personal details, and upload supporting documents. The Embassy will screen and pre-approve the applicants who meet the requirements. (Please check the status of your application after 1-3 working days)

Step 2 The applicants can check their status online if they have been preapproved. They will be contacted by email if the Embassy requires more documents. The applicants who are pre-approved passengers can then buy flight tickets and book their ASQ hotels. Kindly note that a copy of (1) a valid visa or reentry permit, with supporting documents, (2) health insurance policy covering all expenditures and medical expenses related to COVID-19 with a minimum coverage of 100,000 USD, (3) air ticket and ASQ hotel booking confirmation, (4) vaccine certificate/passport (if applicable) have to be uploaded in order to get the COE. (Please check the status of your application after 1-3 working days.)

Step 3 When the COE has been approved, the applicants can check their status online and click to download their COE.

** The Embassy reserves the right to request additional documents as necessary.

7. Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) / Alternative Local Quarantine (ALQ) / Organisational Quarantine (OQ) / Golf Quarantine (GQ)

Due to the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration's decision on 29 April 2021, those who arrive in Thailand from 6 May 2021 onwards shall strictly comply with public health measures and will be subject to a 14-day quarantine at a Government-designated Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) / Alternative Local Quarantine (ALQ) / Organisational Quarantine (OQ) / Golf Quarantine (GQ) facility at their own expenses.

Travellers who have complete dose(s) of approved COVID-19 vaccination (Pfizer-BioNtech, AstraZeneca, Covishield, Sinovac, Johnson&Johnson) no less than 14 days before entering Thailand may be subject to 7-day quarantine.

A list of Alternative State Quarantine (ASQs) / Alternative Local Quarantine (ALQ) / Golf Quarantine (GQ) can be downloaded from the Embassy's website. Please find further information at http://hsscovid.com and kindly note the following:

- 1. Passengers arrived at Suvarnabhumi Airport/ Don Mueang International Airport can be quarantined in ASQ and ALQ located in Chonburi and Prachinburi.
- 2. Passengers arrived at Phuket International Airport can be quarantined in ALQ located in Phuket and Phang-nga.
- 3. For travellers entering Thailand via Ban Klong Luek (Aranyaprathet) Border Checkpoint can be quarantined in ALQ located in Prachinburi.
- 4. For travellers entering Thailand via 2nd Thai–Lao Friendship Bridge can be quarantined in ALQ located in Mukdahan.

To make a reservation, the applicants may contact a hotel directly OR through authorized online platforms: (1) https://entrythailand.go.th/; (2) https://www.agoda.com/quarantineth; (3) https://asq.locanation.com/; (4) https://asq.ascendtravel.com/.

For GQ, travellers need to contact the golf facilities to make a reservation and submit the reservation confirmation in a confirmation letter or an Affidavit of Support letter from the Ministry of Public Health.

8. Health insurance

As mentioned in the check list above, a copy of health insurance policy covering all expenditures and medical expenses related to COVID-19 with a minimum coverage of

100,000 USD is required for most non-Thai nationals who intend to enter Thailand during the COVID-19 situation.

In case it is difficult to find a corresponding health insurance policy in your area, the Embassy wishes to draw your attention to the 'Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Insurance Protection Program for Foreigners Traveling to Thailand', which is a cooperation between the Thai General Insurance Association (TGIA), the Thai Life Insurance Association (TLAA) and 16 leading life and non-life insurance companies in Thailand under the regulation of the Office of Insurance Commission of Thailand. This insurance policy has been approved by the Royal Thai Government and can be used in the application for visa and the COE. For more information, please visit http://covid19.tgia.org.

** A fit-to-fly health certificate is no longer required.

9. ThailandPlus Application

From 14 January 2021, all travelers who have received COEs are required to download and register via the ThailandPlus Application. They are required to show a QR code generated from the registration via the Application to be scanned by the Thai authority upon arrival in Thailand.
