

**ENTRY REQUEST TO THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND
FOR NON-THAI NATIONALS**

Non-Thai nationals may submit a request for a Certificate of Entry (COE), issued by the Royal Thai Embassy, and may enter the Kingdom of Thailand if they fall under the categories listed below. All requests are to be submitted to the Royal Thai Embassy by email at consular@thaiembnepal.org.np

Please note that **your request will only be considered once all the required documents have been submitted via the above mentioned email only.** It is recommended that the applicants should submit all their documents at least 10 working days before the expected travel date in order to avoid inconveniences to the travel plans.
